



ISG-ISRS-NS-2021: Guidelines for E-Poster Presentation

- Use the E-poster template available on **Symposium Website**: <https://gis-prsc.punjab.gov.in/geomatics2021>. Adhere to the overall design, layout, and font size/type/colour given in the template.
- The E-poster will be displayed in standard Portrait Format.
- The file format should be .PDF, high resolution and size < 2 MB.
- A single PDF file should be uploaded by December 10, 2021.
- Animations/movies will not be supported; please submit in a static PDF file.
- The poster template given on the website is in .pptx format. Participants should save a copy of this .pptx file in .pdf format (use save as option).
- The image quality option should be kept on 330 PPI while preparing the E-poster. This option is available under file> Options > Advance > Image Size and Quality – select 330 PPI. Also, uncheck the "DO not compress the image in file" option.
- The poster should be self-explanatory. The text should be brief, well organized and readable.
- The E-poster will be uploaded on the symposium portal before December 10, 2021. You may make sure that your E-poster is visible properly. In the template, if you observe any discrepancy, report it to isgirsnsldh2021@gmail.com by December 10, 2021. No presentation will be accepted after this date.

Best Poster Awards

The best posters in both student and general categories will be awarded from the posters presented in the symposium.

Things to be noted while preparing poster:

The E-poster needs to be created as per suggestion under

1. The poster title should be displayed prominently at the top of the poster.
2. The text should include (most likely as separate elements of the poster) Introduction, objectives, Methodologies, Results, Conclusion and Acknowledgements.
 - The poster should be self-explanatory. The text should be brief and well organized.
 - The typeface chosen should be a simple and clear one.
 - The correct font size depends significantly on the fonts used in the PDF, and the thumb rule should be that if it is visible well on the computer screen, it shall be visible on the E-Poster Display Screen.

Colour suggestions:

1. When using light backgrounds (white, yellow, light blue), we suggest using dark fonts (black, navy blue, dark green)
2. When using dark backgrounds (blue, purple), we suggest using light fonts (white, yellow, cyan)
3. Avoid using red or green in any fonts or backgrounds as they are colours that are difficult to read
 - Illustrations/images/photographs used in the E-poster should be enlarged enough to show relevant details.
